

Dr. Michelle A. Cretella, MD, FCP is the Executive Director of the American College of Pediatricians. She is a board certified general pediatrician with a special interest in adolescent mental and sexual health.

She graduated from the University of Connecticut School of Medicine in 1994; completed her internship and residency in general Pediatrics with honors at Connecticut Children's Medical Center in 1997, and completed a College Health Fellowship at the University of Virginia Health Center in 1999. She has served on the Board of the American College of Pediatricians since 2005, and on the Board of Directors for the Alliance for Therapeutic Choice (formerly NARTH) since 2010.

Dr. Cretella practiced general pediatrics for 15 years in Rhode Island and Connecticut. Her full-time position as President of the American College of Pediatricians began in April of 2015.

Dr. Cretella has been an active prolife advocate for over twenty years, and she has been published in several lay publications. Avocations include personal training, youth ministry and serving as a certified abstinence educator for her local Catholic school. She lives in Rhode Island with her husband of twenty years and their four children.

Walt Heyer was a husband, father and corporate executive who underwent gender reassignment surgery at the age of 42, going from man to woman. Eight years later, Walt went back to man again and has been restored to his male gender for over 25 years, and married for over 20.

Walt Heyer is an accomplished author and conference speaker with a passion to help others who regret gender change.

His website, SexChangeRegret.com, reaches over 250,000 people a year.

Walt writes for thefederalist.com and thepublicdiscourse.com and has written and published 6 books.

Walt's books include *Trans Life Survivors, Kid Dakota* and the *Secret at Grandma's House; Paper Genders; Gender, Lies and Suicide*; and his autobiography, *A Transgender's Faith*.

Walt desires to raise public awareness about the incidence of regret and the tragic consequences suffered by those who regret undergoing gender change.

Denise Shick is author of *My Daddy's Secret, When Hope Seems Lost,* and *Understanding Gender Confusion*. She also directs Help 4 Families Ministry.

When Denise was nine years old, her father told her a secret: he wanted to be a woman. Over time, this led to him wearing Denise's clothes and abandoning their family. As a result, Denise struggled with her own sexuality, alcohol, and thoughts of suicide.

But, Denise's story is also one of redemption through Christ, and how the love and true life found only in Jesus Christ was demonstrated to her through the love of her husband.

Denise now says: "Today's culture proclaims that a person who chooses to change gender is being honest and courageous—true to his or her nature. Truth? Truth is what aligns with reality, and the reality is my dad was abused as a child.... The "reality" TV shows that portray transgenderism as the new frontier in human freedom and self-fulfillment are not telling the whole story. I know from experience."
