**SB 818** — requires sex ed in Kindergarten to include teaching LGBTQ definitions and masturbation. *Became law.*

**HB 3195** — creates all-gender multiple occupancy public bathrooms. *PASSED House*.

**HB 3447** — felony reduction to misdemeanor for: possession of 40 Oxycodone pills; 40 LSD tabs; 5 Ecstacy pills; <3 grams Heroin, Fentanyl, Meth, PCP; <4 grams Morphine, Petazocine; <5 grams of Cocaine. *PASSED House.* 

#### VOTE: Curran Senate didn't vote Stava-Murray ✓SUPPORT

**HB 1063** — Removes criminal offense of transmission of HIV from Criminal Code of 1961 and 2012. *Became law.*

**SB 2136** — felony prostitution charges expunged. *Became law.*

 B 2789 — gives authority to Dept. of Public Health to close ALL nonpublic schools, including homeschools, if health emergency protocols are not followed.

HB 709 — public information campaign that points illegal aliens to state and federal resources. *Became law.*VOTE: Curran Not Voting | Stava-Murray ✓SUPPORT

**HB 4146** — allows civil suits against men who impregnate women, even consensually; provides for damages of \$10,000 or more, half of which will be placed in a fund to pay for abortions for women from states that restrict abortions.

Not Yet Voted On: Stava-Murray **/**SPONSOR

HB 370 — Repeal of Parental Notice of Abortion. PASSED both Houses; sent to governor.
VOTE: Curran ✓OPPOSE | Stava-Murray ✓SUPPORT

**SB 1169** — removes rights of conscience protection to refuse participation in medical procedures for COVID-19 pandemic. *PASSED both Houses; sent to governor.* **VOTE: Curran ✓OPPOSE | Stava-Murray ✓SUPPORT**
