**SB 818** — requires sex ed in Kindergarten to include teaching LGBTQ definitions and masturbation. *Became law.* 

VOTE: Wilcox ✓OPPOSE | Weber ✓OPPOSE

**HB 3195** — creates all-gender multiple occupancy public bathrooms. *PASSED House*.

VOTE: Wilcox Senate didn't vote | Weber ✓OPPOSE

**HB 24** — introduces 6<sup>th</sup> graders to sexting. *Became law.* 

VOTE: Wilcox ✓OPPOSE | Weber ✓SUPPORT

**HB 156** — puts tampons in boys bathrooms in public schools. *Became law.* 

VOTE: Wilcox ✓OPPOSE | Weber ✓OPPOSE

**HB 3447** — felony reduction to misdemeanor for: possession of 40 Oxycodone pills; 40 LSD tabs; 5 Ecstacy pills; <3 grams Heroin, Fentanyl, Meth, PCP; <4 grams Morphine, Petazocine; <5 grams of Cocaine. *PASSED House.* 

VOTE: Wilcox Senate didn't vote | Weber ✓ OPPOSE

**HB 1063** — Removes criminal offense of transmission of HIV from Criminal Code of 1961 and 2012. *Became law.* 

VOTE: Wilcox ✓OPPOSE | Weber ✓SUPPORT

**SB 2136** — felony prostitution charges expunged. *Became law.* 

VOTE: Wilcox Not Voting | Weber ✓ OPPOSE

**SB 1730** — requires corporations to report sexual orientation and self-identified gender of its directors. *Became law.* 

VOTE: Wilcox ✓OPPOSE | Weber ✓OPPOSE

**HB 135** — allows pharmacists to dispense prescription hormonal contraceptives. *Became law.* 

VOTE: Wilcox ✓OPPOSE | Weber ✓OPPOSE



**HB 1871** — establishes vote by mail sites & curb-side voting; acceptance of mail ballots with no postage. *Became law.* 

VOTE: Wilcox Not Voting | Weber ✓ OPPOSE

**HB 2789** — gives authority to Dept. of Public Health to close ALL nonpublic schools, including homeschools, if health emergency protocols are not followed. *PASSED House.* 

VOTE: Wilcox Senate didn't vote | Weber ✓ OPPOSE

**HB 709** — public information campaign that points illegal aliens to state and federal resources. *Became law.* 

VOTE: Wilcox ✓OPPOSE | Weber ✓OPPOSE

**HB 370** — Repeal of Parental Notice of Abortion. *PASSED* both Houses; sent to governor.

VOTE: Wilcox ✓OPPOSE | Weber ✓OPPOSE

**SB 1169** — removes rights of conscience protection to refuse participation in medical procedures for COVID-19 pandemic. *PASSED both Houses; sent to governor.*
