2026 Voter Guide | U.S. Senate & Congressional Candidate Survey Questions

Federal candidates were asked if they Support or Oppose:

- 1 | H.R. 22 (2025) requires proof of U.S. citizenship to register to vote in federal elections.
- 2 | H.R. 4 (2025) rescinds \$9.4 billion from various agencies that promote programs that are antithetical to American interests, threaten religious liberty, and promote abortion and LGBT interests.
- 3 | H.R. 1 (2025) The One Big Beautiful Bill Act defunded big abortion for 10 years, eliminated tax-funded gender transition procedures, made \$2,000 child tax credit permanent, and more.
- 4 | H.R. 28 (2025) withholds federal funds from schools that allow males to participate in female sports.
- 5 | H.R. 21 (2025) the Born-Alive Abortion Survivors Protection Act would require healthcare workers to provide the same life-saving care to babies born alive after an abortion as those born at the same gestational age.
- 6 | Amdt. 52 to H.R. 8070 (2024) prohibits “gender transition” procedures through military TRICARE health insurance as part of the National Defense Authorization Act of FY 2025.
- 7 | Amdt. 55 to H.R. 8070 (2024) prohibits the U.S. Secretary of Defense from paying for abortions under the National Defense Authorization Act of FY 2025.
- 8 | Amdt. 45 to H.R. 8070 (2024) prohibits government funding of companies engaged in suppressing lawful speech under the National Defense Authorization Act of FY 2025.
- 9 | H.R. 734 (2023) bans men/boys who identify as women/girls from participating in female school sports.
- 10 | H.R. 1425 (2024) requires U.S. Senate approval to agree to the World Health Organization’s Pandemic Preparedness Treaty.
- 11 | H.R. 4 (2025) cut \$8.3 billion from the Dept. of State and USAID plus \$1.1 billion from the Corporation for Public Broadcasting.

2026 Voter Guide | Illinois Statewide Candidate Survey Questions

State candidates were asked if they Support or Oppose:

- A | SB 1950, HFA 2 (2025) legalized physician-assisted suicide by lethal drugs.
- B | SB 2510 (2025) \$55.3 billion budget bill included an increase in lawmaker’s part-time base-salary to \$98,304 (up \$30K since 2019).
- C | HB 3247 (2025) established free tuition and programs through secondary school for illegal aliens, allowing for civil lawsuits and damages if law is violated.
- D | HB 3637 (2025) allows a person who lost their medical license in another state to provide abortions and transgender hormone therapy in Illinois; allows drugs not approved by the FDA but approved by the World Health Organization.
- E | HB 3489 (2025) allows the abortifacient “morning after pill” to be dispensed by a pharmacist without an Rx and paid for with tax dollars.
- F | HB 3709 (2025) mandates universities and colleges recommend doctors that prescribe abortion pills; forces pharmacies to dispense them; removes requirement that the university has a referral agreement with a medical facility in the event of complications.
- G | SB 42 (2025) prohibits law enforcement from stopping and inspecting a vehicle based on the odor of cannabis.
- H | HB 3049 (2025) allows 2 people of any sex to marry one another without an officiant.
- I | SB 1560 (2025) requires students in grades 3-12 to be screened for mental health issues in public schools.
- J | HB 1083 (2025) changes gender-specific nouns to gender-neutral descriptions in the Religious Freedom Protection Act, the Civil Unions Act, and the Rights of Married Persons Act.
